Bond denied in homicide

Prosecutor: Bateman fired the fatal shot in drive-by

Lynchburg charged with murder in the death of Lawrence Giusto early Sunday is believed to be the person who fired the fatal prosecutor said Thursday.

Giusto, 20, died from his injuries shortly after he was taken to the hospital, police have said.
