

City man pleads in restaurant break-ins

A Lynchburg man pleaded guilty Tuesday to charges that he broke into two Lynchburg restaurants to steal money for drugs.

Bruce Allen Powell, 31, will

be sentenced in March on charges of breaking and entering the Roly-Poly Sandwich Shop, and attempted breaking and entering of Donald's Bagels, both on Lakeside Drive, said Deputy Commonwealth's Attorney Chuck Felmlee.

He is being held in the Blue Ridge Regional Jail without

bond.

The case began on July 5 after city police were called to Wyndale Drive near The News & Advance office, where they found Powell on the ground in the middle of the road fighting with another man, according to a
